

Cabinet Decisions taken on 26 March 2009

Cabinet has agreed to the introduction of diesel with sulphur content not exceeding 500 parts per million (ppm) for use by automobiles. The diesel currently used has a sulphur content of 2500 ppm which lead mainly to:

- (a) corrosion and wear of engine systems;
- (b) a decrease in the efficiency of exhaust after-treatment systems;
- (c) respiratory and cardiovascular problems; and
- (d) risks of developing cancer.
